Water for Life

"The Lord answered Moses, 'Walk on ahead of the people. Take with you some of the elders of Israel and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. I will stand there before you by the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it for the people to drink.' So Moses did this in the sight of the elders of Israel."
Exodus 17: 5, 6 (NIV)

My first encounter with the small Bible School at Kiburara, Uganda, was in 1996, during the ADF wars. I can still remember the day the small Bible school population swelled from 75 men, women, and children to well over 2,000 who sought shelter, refuge, and food away from the blazing guns of the rebels. Faustan, Ndungo, Sitariko, and Moses, the staff at the Bible school, opened up their hearts and hands to those who came seeking refuge. All through the four-year war, the Bible college at Kiburara was a place where people could come when they were in trouble.

Yet that place of refuge and shelter for the wider community has itself become a place of suffering. Those who have given so much to others now are looking for the help they need to sustain life.

This bucket garden is an effort to do drip irrigation on a small scale, as a teaching exercise. It also helps the school grow a little food even when their main crops fail.



Let me explain: The Bible School at Kiburara has been nationally run for 15 years. It is a school supported mainly by agricultural practices where teachers and students grow their own food. Because the school does not provide food for students or staff, but only a place to grow the food, the tuition fees are greatly reduced, making the school affordable and practical for the people to attend. It is the only self-sustaining Bible school running on an African economy in East Africa of which I know.

But still they suffer! Why? Lack of rain! The ground at Kiburara is lovely, rich black soil that is 3 feet deep. It could grow anything, but it doesn't. In order to grow crops, two rainy seasons a year are necessary, but those rains have

been unreliable over the last five years. The people need 6 weeks of rain to grow crops, and now they often get only 3 weeks. They do the hard work of digging, planting and weeding but it is discouraging to see no harvest. Often before the beans, corn, peanuts, sweet potatoes, tomatoes, and onions can produce, the rains stop! Their crops die from lack of water! After much prayer and investigation into this circumstance, the Lord has led us to a solution. There is more water than needed less

than one kilometer away in a river that flows all year long. E.M.I., an engineering mission in partnership with us, has designed a solar, drip irrigation system that will allow the school to grow crops all year round. This system will also

provide clean drinking water for the wider community. We are currently raising money to purchase the parts needed for such a system. The total cost is \$62,000. Pray with us that we will be able to help our brothers in Africa as they seek to train the future pastors of Uganda. Pray that the funds needed for the project will come in so that another growing season will not be lost. Pray that God will be able to use this project to open doors for the gospel to the wider community.

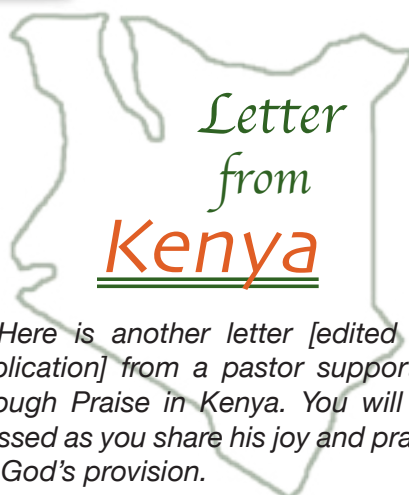

Since his office has no computer equipment, he must use an internet café for all his email communication. The café rates in the city of Abidjan are extremely high. We have the privilege of passing along Brother Cephas' request for our help to purchase some used computer

equipment. Here is the request in his own words:

We have made preliminary contact for a possible building here in Caldwell, Idaho, should we have to move. Thank you to those who have expressed concern and suggested possible solutions. Please continue to pray with us about these changes.

Other News:

- We are working to expand our IMAP ministry in Eastern Europe. We ask that you pray with us about opportunities to help the ministers of the gospel in Russia, Romania and Bulgaria.

- Jim Cardillo has joined our staff as volunteer Director of Special Projects. Jim has been a friend of Praise for many years and brings a heart for helping the cause

of Christ. His current project is the potential development of a medical clinic and pastors' conference in Honduras. Please pray for Jim as he takes up these responsibilities.

- As we have mentioned in previous newsletters, we are in the process of moving our pastors who live and serve in restricted countries over to the administration of The Voice of the Martyrs. This decision is based in the principle of kingdom efficiency, since VOM is already working in Vietnam, China, and Cuba, and we do not want to duplicate kingdom efforts. This will allow us to extend our ministry in Africa, Central America, India and Eastern Europe. We are contacting all of our sponsors who are supporting pastors in communist countries and giving you the option of retaining your pastors as they move to VOM or allowing VOM to find new sponsors. Thank you for your understanding during this transition.
