Pastor Moussa and Véronique Konaté serve the Lord in a suburb of Abidjan in Cote d'Ivoire. Moussa comes from a Muslim background. His name is associated with being a Muslim. In 2010, during the political turmoil of the presidential election, there was much killing between the Islamic north and the Christian south. Pastor Moussa, living in the south, was on the "hit list" because of his Muslim name. One day a mob came, broke down his door and was about to kill him. God put His hand of protection upon Moussa and his life was spared!



The church that Moussa was planting grew to nearly 200 in attendance. They had been renting a large piece of land to hold their worship services until recently. With no explanation, this land was taken from them. The church is under spiritual attack. Over half the members stopped coming to church! Moussa and Véronique now hold the worship service in their small backyard, with 80 to 100 under a tarp supported by poles!

Pray that the Lord would give perseverance and courage to Pastor Moussa. Pray that the Believers who left and those still attending might see that this is spiritual warfare, that the church would growth and that God might be greatly glorified!
